

NEW IN-PERSON ABSENTEE VOTING PROCEDURE

In accordance with recent legislative changes, the In-Person Absentee Voting Procedure at the Geauga County Board of Elections will be similar to how voters vote on Election Day at the polls.

Voters will come in, state their name and address to a staff members, provide an accepted form of identification, provide their signature, receive their ballot, vote and place it in an M-100 scanner. (The ballots placed in the scanners will not be counted until after the polls close on Election Day.)

This process removes the necessity of a voter having to fill out a paper application for an absentee ballot.

If a voter does not have or does not want to provide one of the accepted forms of identification, a voter may complete an absentee ballot application providing their driver's license number or the last four digits of their Social Security number to receive and cast an absentee ballot in-person. This is the process that was previously used.
